Travel tips – packing


We will not be spending much time out doors but it is recommended that students take appropriate clothing for the time of year. The trip is for 1 night so please do not bring lots of luggage.

There is a strict dress code at the Hindu Mandir. Tops must cover the midriff and not be see through. Leg wear short skirts, dresses must be knee length.

It is customary to remove shoes on entry to the Mandir so avoid holes in your socks!

No hats are permitted to be worn inside St Paul's Cathedral.

We will not have time to change before the theatre so you may want to dress smartly throughout the day.
