APPLYING TO COLLEGE



What are my choices?

- **College**
- **Apprenticeship**
- **Traineeship**

College

- **A Levels – 3 or 4 subjects.**
- **International Baccalaureate - 6 subjects.**
- **Diplomas – 1 subject.**

Entry Requirements – A Levels/IB

- **5 GCSEs at 4 or above including English & Maths at 5 or above.**
- **With subjects relevant to your choices at 6 or above.**
- **Check with individual colleges.**

Entry Requirements - Diplomas

- **Level 3** - 4 or 5 GCSEs at 4 or above including Maths and English at 4 or above.
- **Level 2** – 3 or 4 GCSEs at 3 or above including Maths and English at 3 or above.
- **Level 1/Foundation** – Interview.

How do I apply?

Use the Cornwall 16+ Options Form

- You can apply for more than one course.
- You can apply to more than one college.
- School checks and sends the form.
- Forms dropped to library by Friday 1st March.

Apprenticeships

- **You will need a college course as a back up.**
- **Start your research now.**
- **Apprenticeship workshops at the end of March
(Go to Library to book onto these).**
- **Start applying in April/May.**
