Study Support

Core Advanced Extra

How much does it cost?

At Penryn College we do everything we can to offer our Study Support Programme using the resources we have in school to enable us to deliver to the students at no cost. These are considered our **Core (C)** offering.

However, this isn't always possible and sometimes we have to pay external or expert deliverers who enable us to provide high quality, tailored sessions. These activities are considered our **Advanced (A)** offering and will cost each student a nominal £2 per session. *We intend to enable parents to pay via ParentPay in the near future.*

Finally is our **Extra (E)** offering, which includes any activities that take place off site or are delivered by external companies. The cost for these will depend on the activity and students will be informed of these on registering their interest.

Each activity in the booklet has been assigned to one of the categories above. These can be seen under the 'Offer' section of each listing.

Please Note: No child will be penalised on the basis of genuine financial hardship. Please contact Mr Ash if you wish to make a confidential application for financial assistance.



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BE AWARE - COVID!

Unlike in previous years, our clubs and activities can only now contain pupils from existing year group bubbles. Many clubs will also be limited in terms of the numbers they are able to accommodate. **Therefore, we are asking students follow the links to sign up for the clubs.** This will allow staff to plan how to safely accommodate those attending and build a waiting list for those unable to attend.

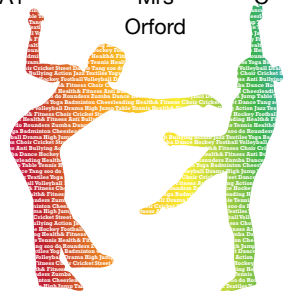

Penryn College Sports Expectations

Our members of staff are very experienced and therefore regularly advise students to wear the correct pieces of equipment as advised by individual NGB's. We have noted that some pupils might ignore this advice and we would welcome your support in reinforcing the kit advice listed below with your son/daughter.

If a child forgets to bring their gum shield and/or shin pads and they are concerned about the safety implications then they should talk to the member of staff responsible for that session. It may be possible to borrow some shin pads and the school does keep temporary gum shields which can be moulded quickly in an emergency.

As Penryn College players we will:

- Ensure we have ticked our names on the team sheet and taken note of depart **and** return details
 - Always catch up on any work missed through fixtures in lesson times
- Wear the correct kit for both training sessions and fixtures. This is the players responsibility.
 - For Football:** Shin Pads **MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES**
 - For Rugby:** Gum shields are **OPTIONAL**
 - For Hockey:** Gum shields are **OPTIONAL** / Shin Pads **MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES**
- Exhibit positive and sportsmanlike behaviour at all times, to our own team mates and officials
 - Inform our coach if we have **ANY** pre-existing, or new, injury that may affect us
 - Recognise and thank our opponents and officials after every match
 - Never use inappropriate language, whether directed at ourselves, another player or the referee
 - Behave with dignity and pride in all circumstances, win, lose or draw
- Always attend training and inform our coach should we **not be available**
