Dear Applicant

Thank you for your interest in the position of Teaching Assistant at Penryn College. We require full-time Teaching Assistants to support students with special educational needs in a variety of subject areas throughout the school. You should have excellent literacy, numeracy and interpersonal skills, evidence of effective working with young people and high expectations for pupils' achievements. Previous manual handling training/experience and personal care are an advantage.

These are term time only positions, with additional inset training days as required, working Monday 8.25am – 4.30pm and Tuesday to Friday 8.25am – 3.40pm and so the salary is proportionately reduced both in the number of hours worked and the number of weeks worked during the year. Working 34 hours per week this position is paid for 43.128 weeks per year. The actual annual starting salary for a full-time Teaching Assistant is £13,216 per annum.

These roles are due to start as soon as possible and are fixed term until 31st August 2022, in the first instance.

The closing date for application forms is 27th September 2021

Interviews will be held on w/c 4th October 2021.
