Unit Overview

- Explore rhythmic techniques; be able to perform confidently using rhythm notation and language. Use a range of time signatures and tempi.
- Explore tonality (scales and modes); be able to improvise using pitch and investigating the relationship between pitches
- Explore **melodic** techniques; be able to improvise melodies in different genres
- Explore harmony; be able to explore harmonic progressions from different genres
- Explore expression; Perform in ensemble groups using extremes of tempo, dynamics and articulations
- Explore a range of stylistic features in different music genres

Language for Learning

Rhythm - a strong, regular repeated pattern of sound

Pitch - High/Low

Tonality – which scale a piece uses

Timbre – Sound quality

Structure - How music is organised

Phrase - Musical sentence

Harmony – when notes are played at the same time, for example chords.

Texture - Layers of sound

Tempo - Speed

Dynamics - Volume

Stylistic Features – elements of a piece of music which are typical of a certain genre
