## You will learn;

- How music is composed and performed in the Baroque and Classical eras using a range of musical features
- How Baroque music uses sequence, repetition and imitation to develop musical ideas
- How Classical music texture and structure including melody and accompaniment

## You will be able;

- To recognise and perform using musical features from the Baroque Era
- To recognise and compose using musical features from the Classical Era using musical notation and music technology
- To describe how music through history uses tonality, harmony and instrumentation

#### **Unit Overview:**

## Be able to recognise and perform using musical features from the Baroque Era:

- Imitation: Use of body percussion and instruments to demonstrate an understanding of imitation.
- Perform in ensembles to demonstrate accuracy in the use of imitation
- Sequence:
- Perform an individual part in a chosen ensemble piece and Ground Bass

## Be able to recognise and compose using musical features from the Classical Era:

- Improvise 2 & 4 bar phrase patterns in Major and Minor keys
- Simple broken chords; Improvise melodies over a given chord sequence in Major and Minor keys
- Compose a waltz melody over a broken chord pattern. Use notation and music technology to communicate.

## Language for Learning:

**Context**: when, where and why something happens. Secular vs Sacred. Era.

**Musical Features:** Imitation. Repetition. Sequence. Musical phrase

Harmony: Chords I, IV, V. Alberti Bass. Ground Bass.

**Tonality:** Major vs Minor Scales

**Structure**: Binary, Ternary, Theme and Variation

Musical Methods: Composing. Notation. Ensemble.
