- Services for adults or children with specific needs (learning disabilities, sensory impairments, long-term health issues) e.g. residential/respite/domiciliary care)
- Services for older adults (residential/domiciliary care)
- The role of informal social care (provided by relatives, friends and neighbours)

# **Key Words**

**Primary care** – first point of contact you are likely to have with the NHS – e.g. doctor or dentist

Secondary/tertiary care – further care not offered by primary service. For example seeing a specialist – secondary. Further, advanced treatment – tertiary

**Stigma** – when you feel that others disapprove of your circumstances and you have strong feelings of shame or embarrassment about something
