This is a one year contract to start in September 2022 until 31st August 2023. Applications will be considered although we will consider applications for part time.

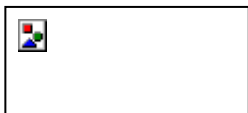
The closing date for completed application forms is Tuesday 21st June at 9am. Interviews will be held during week commencing 27th June.
