Dear Applicant

Thank you for your interest in the position of Teaching Assistant at Penryn College. We require fixed-term, full-time Teaching Assistants to support students with special educational needs in a variety of subject areas throughout the school. These positions will be until 31.08.2023.

You should have excellent literacy, numeracy and interpersonal skills, evidence of effective working with young people and high expectations for pupil's achievements. Previous manual handling training/experience and personal care are an advantage.

These are term time only positions, with additional inset training days as required, working Monday 8.25am – 4.30pm and Tuesday to Friday 8.25am – 3.40pm and so the salary is proportionately reduced both in the number of hours worked and the number of weeks worked during the year. Working 34 hours per week this position is paid for 43.128 weeks per year. The actual annual starting salary for a full-time Teaching Assistant is £14,006 per annum. These roles are due to start in September 2022.

The closing date for application forms is Tuesday 21st June. Interviews will be held during w/c 27th June.

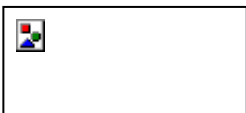
