It is not an enforceable rule but it is usually observed</p> <p>Hooliganism – the disorderly aggressive and often violent behaviour by spectators at sporting events.</p> <p>Blood doping – a prohibited method that involves removing blood a few weeks before a competition and then reinjecting it just prior to competition</p> |
