**Course title: OCR National Enterprise and Marketing**

**Assessment:**

**RO64: external exam 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023 (provisional) 40% of final grade**

This term (Autumn) we will be covering the remaining parts of **R064** in class, in preparation for the exam in JUNE 2023. We will complete LO5 and LO6 by January's Mock Exam and return to revise all of the 6 LOs before June.

November 2022: Walking, talking mock exam on R064 (LO1, LO2, LO3. LO4. LO5, LO6)

**January 2023: Mock exam R064**

**RO65: Internal assessed task (Coursework element 1) 30% of final grade**

Last year you should have completed your **R065** coursework, it has been marked and fed back, any final improvements must be submitted by **31<sup>st</sup> Jan.**

**RO66: Internal assessed task (coursework element 2) 30% of final grade**

After the January Mocks we will begin working on **R066** – the second piece of coursework. For R066 you must create a portfolio of work and give a presentation. The presentations will be assessed in March 2023 and must be finally submitted by **31st March.**

All supporting resources will be on our Showbie group. I have organised the folders according to the 3 units: R064, R065 and R066. In each of these folders is a 'Helpful Resources' folder, where you can find overviews, checklists and links to other useful resources online, such as Seneca learning units.

It is important to note that the knowledge required for Cambridge Nationals Enterprise and Marketing Level 1 - 2 is NOT the same as the Seneca courses or other Business GCSEs. I urge you to use the notes and revision guides that we use in class, so that you can get a fantastic grade in this course.
