Students will be e-mailed a link on Monday 27th February with detailed instructions on how to log in and complete their profile. The link will come from Mrs Ohly, Yearbook Coordinator, so students will need to look out for this. Mr Herring, Year 11 tutors, and Mrs Ohly will talk students through the process of completing their profile during an assembly next week.

The Yearbook is a wonderful memento for students to look back on to remember their time at Penryn College. Due to GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations) introduced in May 2018, your child will need to sign a form giving consent for their photo and details to appear in the Yearbook. These forms will be e-mailed to your child on Monday, along with the joining instructions. Unfortunately, any students who do not sign the form will not be able to appear in the Yearbook. Please note that the profile and consent form must be returned to Mrs Ohly by Friday 17th March.

The Yearbook will be hardback and laminated, costing £16.50. This will be added to ParentPay after half term. All orders will need to be placed by Tuesday 2nd May.
