

## Class of 2023 Prom - Thursday 29th June

Dear Parent/Carer(s)

I am writing to confirm the final details for this year's Prom. We are delighted that we have sold a record number of tickets, and we are looking forward to a busy and memorable night for all. It will be held at **The Falmouth Hotel on Thursday 29**<sup>th</sup> **June** and arrival will be from **6.00pm**. Students will be called to **dinner at 7.00pm** and the evening will **finish promptly at 11.00pm**.

Please remember to send your young person with money to buy non-alcoholic drinks from the bar.

In order to make the event as safe and as smooth as possible, please can we request the following:

- Transport providers that you may have booked need to be informed to enter the hotel car
  park from the driveway on the seafront, as we will be operating a one-way system for
  transport on the evening. All vehicles will exit onto Melvill Road. We would also advise
  staggering arrival times between 6.00pm 6.40pm. This helps with the photography as well
  as avoiding congestion.
- As all students will be under the age of 18, please could you help us to ensure that no
  alcohol is consumed before or during the Prom. We need to inform you that any students
  we believe to be under the influence at any point during the Prom will be asked to leave
  immediately. Parents/carers will be called and the student will need to be collected for
  safety reasons.
- We also kindly ask that students do not bring tobacco, cigarettes or vapes to the Prom, or smoke in any of the areas designated to us by the hotel. This is a non-smoking event.

Students have been allocated designated spaces inside and outside of the hotel where they will be supervised. We ask that they do not leave these areas for safety purposes, as once they have left the designated areas, they will **not be allowed to re-enter the Prom.** 

**Prom tickets can be collected** from Mrs Ohly in the HR Office on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June and Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June, between 8.30am - 2.30pm. Students **must bring their tickets** on the evening to gain entry to the Prom. The table plan can also be viewed at the same time as collecting tickets.
