## **Prom 2024**

I am delighted to be able to provide you with further details regarding our School Prom. As previously communicated, it will be taking place on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024 at the Falmouth Hotel.

Tickets will go on sale on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May at a cost of £35.00 per person and will remain on sale until Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June. Tickets can be paid for via ParentPay. The price includes a three-course meal, a disco and a photobooth. Students will need to have money with them to purchase soft drinks, although tap water will be available on the tables.

We will have a designated area in the hotel including some outside space. There will be staff supervising these areas and we will have additional security on the site. Please be aware that once your son/daughter leaves our designated area during the evening, they will not be able to return to the Prom.

May I also remind you that this is a school event and therefore no alcohol, tobacco or any illicit substances should be consumed before or during the event. We will remove any pupils from the Prom if we believe they may be under the influence in order to ensure that all students and staff have a safe and enjoyable evening. Please support us by reiterating this message to your son/daughter.

The menu choices sheet will be e-mailed to students next month and they will need to be returned to Ms Cooper in the Front Office before Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June.

We would be delighted to see all students at the Prom, but behaviour and attitude will be monitored over the next few months, along with attendance at all exams.
