Penryn College strongly believes in the value of our Outdoor Education programme and our philosophy in 'Achieving through Challenge'. For this reason, it gives me great pleasure to be able to offer you the opportunity to book your child a place on the Year 7 to 8 transition days in July. This will, I am sure, bring a fantastic end to your child's first year at Penryn College and an opportunity for students to spend time with their Head of Year 8 and new Year 8 tutors.

The two-day itinerary will include a team building day on Portreath Beach and orienteering at Tehidy Woods.
