Dear Parent/Carer(s)

Thank you again for your continued support in helping your son/daughter prepare for their upcoming exams. We are proud of how they have prepared. We have our first exams next week in Health and Social Care, Drama and Biology.

We have reminded students this week that they need to arrive in plenty of time, as these are national exams and we cannot change the start times. Students must be ready for all morning exams for a prompt 8.40am start. For afternoon exams, pupils must be in Kernewek Hall promptly at 12.45pm.

We have also reminded students that if they miss an exam, they will not be able to re-sit, and the paper will not be graded. If your son/daughter is unable to come in for an exam or is running late, please phone the school reception (01326 372379) with plenty of warning, so we can guide you through the next steps.

Please see attached a copy of the exams timetable, masterclasses and revision sessions running during the exam period. Where subjects are crossed out, all exams have been taken for that subject and pupils can use this time for independent revision.

Please can I remind you that students are expected to attend school on a full-time basis up to and including Friday 7th June. Pupils will be in timetabled lessons being taught by subject experts until all exams for that subject are completed. They can then use this lesson time for independent study of other subject areas.

We would like all students to attend school after Friday 7th June until they sit their final exams. However, as a parent/carers, you may request for your child to study from home and only come into school for exams from Monday 10th June, if you feel this would be beneficial for them.

We will be sending you a booking link later this half term. For safeguarding purposes, students will only be able to sign out of the building if they have parental permission to leave the site during the school day. They will not be able to leave the site during this period if they have a morning and afternoon exam.
