
#### Weather

We are delighted to share the fantastic achievements of our students in this year's Inette Austin-Smith Work Experience Competition, organised and hosted by CFD Architects Ltd.





Appointments will take place in the main street and hall. You will be sent a booking summary and map ready for the day. Please do not arrive before your first appointment time
