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School Lockers




Due to various issues, we have requested that all students clear out their school lockers by 18th December.

ClassCharts



We are seeing great feedback and engagement from parents/carers with the use of ClassCharts. Please note that all parents/carers will need to use this platform for key school communications. Please see below important updates:

Check your notifications:

Ensure you have enabled notifications in the app and check your email regularly for updates.

ATTENDANCE reporting absences and uploading documents

If your child is absent, you will be able to use ClassCharts to upload evidence directly (such as a doctor's note or appointment card). This helps us keep accurate records and ensures your child's absence is correctly authorised.

DETENTIONS

You will be alerted if a detention has been set for your child (lunch time or after school). This will be our primary way of communicating when your child is required to attend a detention.

How detention alerts work

- When a detention is set, you will receive a notification via the ClassCharts app and by email.
- If your child does not attend a scheduled after school detention, you will automatically be notified through ClassCharts, and an email.
- Our behaviour system includes a clear review and escalation process for missed detentions. If a detention is missed, the matter will be escalated in line with our school's behaviour policy.
- If your child has **not attended a planned after school detention**, you will be notified via ClassCharts and sent an email to inform you, so you are aware.

- It is an attendance and safeguarding concern if they do not attend and we need to alert you they have not arrived as expected. Please ensure you know where they are and that they are safe.
- A parent must provide official evidence of a medical appointment (e.g., appointment card, letter, or confirmation text/email) if your child is unable to attend an after-school detention.

 the App Store or Google Play, or access it online
 at https://www.classcharts.com/parent/login. Use the unique access code provided by
