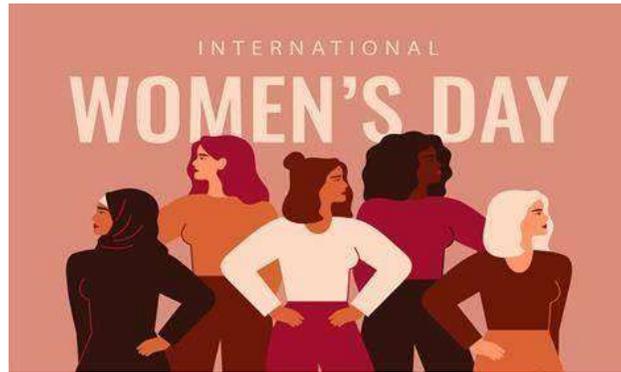
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## Assemblies this week

Please note that families can only book one appointment slot per subject.

- From **12th March at 7pm**, the booking goes live and at first you will only be able to book in appointments for three priority subjects.
- From **19th March at 7pm** you will be able to return to the booking system to make further appointments in addition to the first three, if you so wish.

You'll be sent an email reminder of your bookings shortly after scheduling them.

We'll send out another reminder an hour before your first scheduled appointment which contains a link to access the system and speak to the teachers.

If a member of staff is unable to speak to you on the evening, they will contact you at a later date.
